- The science curriculum at IMS is inquiry based. As a result, students conduct many laboratory experiments that are a critical component of learning scientific concepts and skills.
- When students are absent and need to make up a lab, take a test, work on projects or seek additional help from a science teacher, they need to let their science teacher know that they will be attending after school help. Occasionally the rooms may change due to coaching and other responsibilities.
- Students can either make arrangements for parents to pick them up or they can go to the library to Homework Club until the activity bus arrives.
